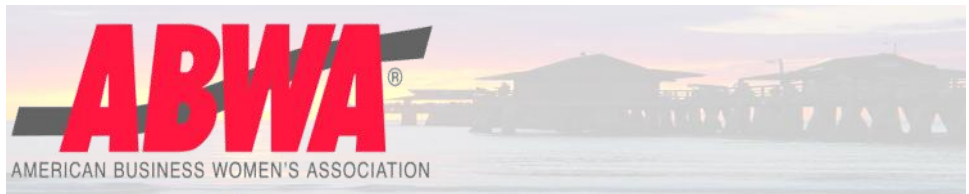

Women Billionaires

According to [Forbes World Billionaires list](#), women currently only make up 2% of the world's billionaires. As I think it is time for this change, I wanted to offer three of Susie Orman's top tips for more women to break into the billionaires club.

Don't treat yourself like you're on sale. If you're reluctant to put a real value on what you do, then it diminishes who you are.

As Suze explains, women tend to devalue what they do. This creates a vicious cycle: "When you devalue what you do, it becomes inevitable that you—and those around you—devalue who you are." Women will settle for less: They may offer discounted prices on their services, or accept a smaller raise, even when the company is doing well. They have to ask for what they know is "right."

Listen to Your Gut

Women are compassionate towards those in need. Instead of going with their gut they sometimes overlook the obvious and make an emotional money mistake. "An employee, a business partner or associate will approach you saying, 'I need to borrow or an advance of \$5,000.' You'll think, 'I don't want to' and yet you say 'Okay,'" Suze explains. So, think twice before you say "yes," if your gut is saying "No."

No Blame, No Shame

Two of the biggest emotional burdens that can lead to your business failing are shame and blame. Suze explains: "Women don't often feel confident around money making decisions. Instead of asking questions, women will feel shameful and defer their decision to others or

stay stuck in a pattern of inaction. Blaming someone else for a situation makes you feel powerless against the situation as you mistakenly now believe someone else now holds the power.

Shame only serves to hold you back as you will weigh you down and stop you from the difficult decision you made need to make." Release yourself from blame and shame today and commit to never stop asking questions as the only people who truly fail are those who stop trying.

Lessons from *On the Wings of Hibou*

First book by Neapolitan Member, Raven Lamoreux-Dodd

While this book is a journey of my transformation, it's also a journey of Every Woman's path toward her own powerful self. New York, 1983 - "What was the look about?" "Too much information," Jim replied. "What do you mean?" I asked. "You give away so much, you lose your mystery. Aren't you being a bit picky?" I asked. "If I were talking to someone else perhaps, but in your case no," he replied. "What is that supposed to mean?" I protested. "You have a habit of explaining yourself. The other day when you were offered meat you declined saying that you are a vegetarian. You went on to explain why, for how long and gave a medical report. Why not just say 'no thank you'? You're not on trial. You give up your authority when you explain your actions. You give up your power. You have so much to share with people. Why dilute it with excuses and justifications?" he said.

I felt that I had done something wrong. "I'm sorry Jim, I try to be friendly to people," I said. "Apologies are not necessary; you're giving up your power again," he said. "You're not going to cut me any slack are you?" I asked. "Of course not, you're a warrior, you need to be impeccable," he replied. *Chapter 11, p.57.*

Lesson 1: If you solve the mystery for them, they lose interest. I have always been a teacher, starting out very young as a ski instructor. It is my nature to try to give people as much information as I can. Jim taught me that people can only absorb so much information in the moment. I tended to ramble on and add bits here and there, explain everything. Now I under-

stand and give students and clients the important parts and let them process it themselves. They can always ask questions if they want more.

Lesson 2: Our presence is often more important than our words. When we are quiet we can listen, observe people's body language and feel what is going on beneath the surface. Just being there can comfort a person. There are times to talk and times to listen.

Lesson 3: You don't need a lawyer! Jim used to catch me defending myself and whispered that to me. It was a great reminder. I put it on a note and stuck it to the bathroom mirror until I got it. It took me a long time to "get" these lessons. When I did, I had much more confidence and began learn that my authentic self is my powerful self. What a relief! I just have to be me. My favorite quote for this is, "Nobody can be exactly like me. Even I have trouble doing it." *Tallulah Bankhead*
